Nassau TRACT has now joined The Learning Plan community. All registration for our courses, conferences, workshops and activities will take place online although a check will still have to be mailed to the office to complete the registration process. All the information you need will be found online. This will allow you to track and keep a permanent record of all the courses and activities you have attended through Nassau TRACT online at the My Learning Plan website. Lost your certificate? No problem. Print another one for yourself online. Forgot the course you signed up for, the starting date or the location? No problem. Log onto your my Learning Plan account and view all the information instantly.

If your district is already a member of My Learning Plan you will use your existing account to login and register for all Nassau TRACT Teacher Center activities. If your district does not belong to My Learning Plan, you will view our fall catalog online. If you wish to register for a course, you will set up an account for yourself. There is no charge for this account and at no time will you incur any costs for your participation with My Learning Plan. There are instructions online as well as a help screen to help you through the enrollment process.

The process is simple and easy and all your information is stored online for you to access 24 hours, seven days a week. You can register for our fall courses at any time as our catalog is available for your viewing 24/7. Please remember to send the course fee after you have registered online.
