NEW COURSE

Intel Teach Program-Essentials Course

This course helps teachers learn how, when and where to incorporate technology tools and resources into their current curriculum to help their students develop higher-order thinking skills. Participants learn new ways to create assessment tools and align lesson plans with state and national standards.

Upon completion of the course, teachers will have produced an integrated unit of instruction ready to use in their own classrooms. This particular course will be a hybrid course with a combination of in-class sessions and online learning participation.

*NOTE: This course includes 15 hours of class time (12/1, 12/8, 8-4 pm) and an additional 16 hours of on-line time (12/9/07 - 1/25/08).

As an added bonus, through a grant provided by the Intel® Foundation, teachers can now earn three graduate credits from NYIT.

You can receive 3 graduate credits from NYIT School of Education, at an additional cost of \$350, payable at the first class. The final session FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS will be on 2/2/08 from 8 am-4 pm (Optional lab session for in-service, but required for Graduate students of 8 hours) This option will be discussed on the first meeting date.

Please check with your district regarding the approval of in-service credit for this course.
